






# Beaming faces as pupils celebrate their results


This newsletter provides a summary of our 2019 GCSE and A-Level results and also captures the vision for our inclusive curriculum which is designed to inspire, challenge and empower our students.

Sustainable school improvement such as this can only be achieved where staff, governors, students and parents work closely together and this has been true of The Lakes School during the last four years. We are always listening and we will continue to do all that we can to support our students and their families

One of our most important responsibilities is to ensure that all of our students leave The Lakes School well equipped with all that they need to live a happy life and to make a positive contribution to their community. We are particularly proud of one impressive statistic which is that, over the last five years, 100% of our students have moved on to further study at Sixth Form, college or university, or have secured a prestigious place on an apprenticeship programme or employment with training. Students leave The Lakes School with a plan for the future and this is a wonderful advert for our school. We would like to take this opportunity to pass on a heartfelt thank you to all of our students who took exams this year; you did yourselves proud!







As you can see from the data on the first two pages, our 2019 GCSE outcomes in English and maths are consistently at or above national averages which is a result of the great work we do here at The Lakes School and the wonderful partnership that exists between staff, students and parents.


Figures 1 to 3 illustrate the fantastic achievement of our GCSE students across English Language, English Literature and Maths where students have consistently performed at or above the national average for each subject. English and Maths are the foundation for success in so many subjects, a key measure by which school effectiveness is judged.

Figure 5 highlights even further success with English as 76% of students at The Lakes School achieved a grade 4 or higher in English Language or English Literature, above the national averages for both Language and Literature. Achieving a grade 4 in both English and Maths is a key indicator for the school and we are particularly pleased that the school has yet again performed above the 2019 national average on this indicator as shown in figure 6.

Achieving a grade 4 in English or Maths is called a standard pass and we are equally pleased with our impressive results for achieving a grade 5 in these subjects, also called a strong pass. Figure 7 highlights the achievement of our students at this level.

Furthermore, the English and Maths outcomes for boys and girls demonstrates the strong ethos at The Lakes School where all students are expected to achieve well. The school remains rooted in comprehensive values, the foundations for which were laid in 1965 when the school opened, and these values will continue to be a huge part of the fabric of the school for years to come. Figures 8 to 10 illustrate just how well our students have achieved when compared to the national averages for English and Maths.

Our GCSE outcomes for 2019 are likely to improve further as the results of re-marks are returned so keep your eyes peeled for an update later this term.



The Lakes School has been on an impressive journey during the last five years and we have stayed true to our values of providing an inclusive curriculum for all of our students. A curriculum that recognises the need for all students to develop a strong knowledge base across a broad range of subjects whilst also being able to access personalised programmes that ensure students develop the skills and personal qualities they need to succeed in their studies and in later life.


