



Helping your child prepare for Maths GCSE

To prepare for the maths GCSE don't simply think about "revising". Instead, think about "revision and practice". It's important with maths to *practice* skills.

Step 1

Make sure your child has somewhere quiet to work, music doesn't help revision. Ideally at a table.

Step 2

Remove all distractions.

- Mobile phones
- Games consoles
- Televisions
- Siblings

Step 3

Make sure your child has a suitable amount of time to revise. Revision timetables can be useful to ensure this happens. Help them stick to it.

Next Steps

Mix it up a bit with varied revision, include practice papers and questions. Don't stick with the same topic all evening. Your child has been given a range of websites and printed resources to help them revise for maths.
