### Japan

You may well be aware that we recently enjoyed a highly successful trip to Japan and we took advice throughout the organisation of the trip as the virus began to spread. It is important to state that the government advice continues to be very clear on what to do if you return from certain countries. Returning from Japan is not a cause for concern **unless you present with certain symptoms**. Japan is classed as a **category 2** country and the [gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk) website states the following: **Category 2**: Travellers do not need to undertake any special measures, but if they develop symptoms they should self-isolate and call NHS 111.

The government says that **only people returning from Japan who present with identified symptoms** should self isolate for 14 days and call 111. Our Japan trip staff and students do not present with the identified symptoms and they therefore do not need to self isolate. There is therefore no cause for concern by any members of the school community.

In closing, we would like to reassure you that we will be in touch with parents directly should the virus affect our immediate school community.
